Made from Rhode Island Greenings, this refreshing cider drinks more like a coastal Italian white wine with wonderful minerality and complexity.vThe Greening is a well-known American heirloom apple that dates back to the 17th century - making it one of the oldest cultivated varieties in the world.

OUR STORY

City Orchard was founded by the serendipitous meeting of three like-minded Houstonians - well one true Houstonian and two northerners who have made Houston their adopted city for over two decades. objective is simple; create the best ciders from the best ingredients in a welcoming environment. With family-owned farms along the shores of Lake Ontario, City Orchard taps deep into the roots of Great Lakes Apple Country. We press carefully selected apples on the farm, truck the juice to Houston, and produce traditional ciders in an urban setting - we are an orchard in the city.
